



## Annual Report on Bill S-211 Compliance (May 30, 2024)

This report is a joint filing for the 2023 fiscal year for the corporations of Armo Tool Limited and Abuma Manufacturing Limited both of which are based in London, Ontario.

Armo Tool is a leading supplier of stamping dies, precision tooling and custom automation. Abuma Manufacturing are experts in contract manufacturing. All manufacturing occurs in Canada and products are sold both inside and outside of Canada. There are also goods produced outside Canada imported into Canada.

We are a vertically integrated manufacturer with full design, assembly, electrical, programming and machine shop capabilities. Armo Tool leverages a partnership with an overseas die designer/manufacturer as the sole source of die imports. All other materials and components are sourced from a local network of distributors and suppliers.

A comprehensive policy focused on Bill S-211 compliance has been established. All management and our purchasing team members are to be trained in this policy which includes due diligence processes for risk assessment of the supply chain. These processes include ongoing supply chain risk analysis, assessments and audits to ensure compliance. Suppliers have provided declarations of compliance with the act within their supply chains and will be required to adhere to this declaration as a condition of engagement.

There has been no current evidence of the use of child and/or forced labour within our supply chains and therefore no requirement for remediation.

Both Armo Tool and Abuma Manufacturing condemn child labour and forced labour in any form. A firm stance is taken to not conduct business with suppliers who engage in either of these practices.
